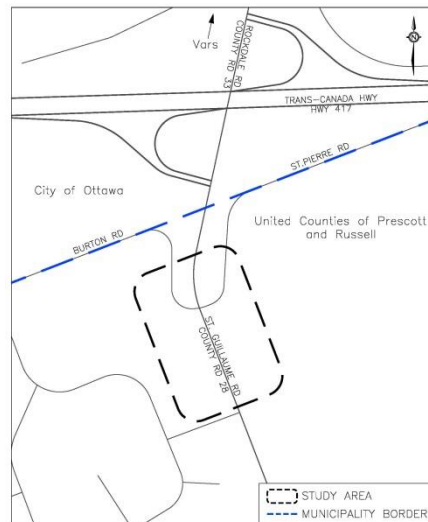
INTRODUCTION

The United Counties of Prescott and Russell is initiating an Environmental Assessment (EA) and preliminary/detail design study for intersection improvements at the County Road 28 (St-Guillaume Road) and Burton Road / St-Pierre Road intersection in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Act.

This EA Study will examine intersection, drainage and roadway alternatives and recommend a preferred alternative to address the needs of the Study Area. The Study will also determine any property acquisition required to implement the project.

STUDY PROCESS

The County Road 28 and Burton Road / St-Pierre Road Intersection Reconstruction EA Study is being conducted as a Schedule B EA Study under the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2007)*, as amended in 2015. The Study will complete Phases 1 and 2 of the Class EA Process by establishing the need and justification for the project, considering all reasonable alternatives with acceptable effects on the natural, social and cultural environments, and proactively involving the public.
