Environmental Assessment Study

BACKGROUND

The United Counties of Prescott and Russell has completed an Environmental Assessment (EA) study for improvements to the County Road 28 (St-Guillaume Road) and Burton Road / St-Pierre Road intersection in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process.

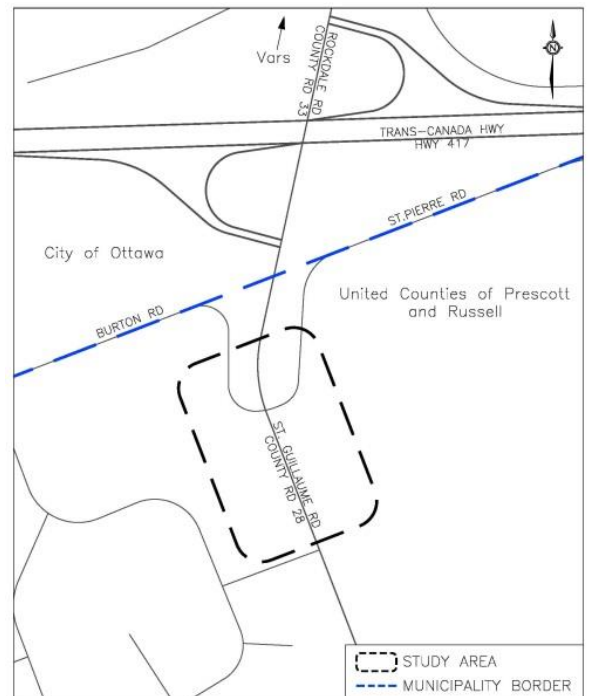
This EA Study has examined intersection, drainage and roadway alternatives and a Recommended Plan has been developed to address the needs of the Study Area.

STUDY PROCESS

The County Road 28 (St-Guillaume Road) and Burton Road / St-Pierre Road Intersection Reconstruction EA Study was completed as a Schedule B EA Study under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2015). The Study has completed Phases 1 and 2 of the Class EA.

PROJECT FILE REPORT REVIEW

NOTICE OF COMPLETION

If there are any concerns regarding the project that cannot be resolved in discussion with the United Counties, a person or party may request that the Minister of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses Individual Environmental Assessments. Requests, with reasons, must be received by the Minister and by the Director of the Environmental Assessment Branch of the MECP (at the addresses noted in this notice) within 30 days of this notice, **prior to April 30, 2020**. The request must also be copied to the United County's Project Manager identified below.

As of July 1, 2018, a Part II Order Request Form must be used to request a Part II Order in accordance with O. Reg. 152/18. The Part II Order Request Form is available online on the Forms Repository website <http://www.forms.ssb.gov.on.ca/> by searching "Part II Order" or "012-2206E" (the form ID number).

If there are no requests received within the 30-day review period, the project will receive environmental clearance. Subsequently, the project may proceed to the detail design and contract preparation phase and subsequent construction, depending on available funding.
